At its January meeting, the St. Paul Police Federation issued its endorsement of incumbent St. Paul City councilmember's Deborah Montgomery and Dan Bostrom. Both are former St. Paul Police officers and members of the Federation.

St. Paul Police Federation President Dave Titus stated that it was the knowledge the two incumbents possessed of the dangers of public safety work that won the Federation's endorsement for the two veteran office holders. "They remember where they came from and continue to work very hard to keep both our city and its police officers safe," said Titus.

He also pointed out that the Federation membership appreciates the great effort by a number of councilmembers to add officers to the police department. "The Federation recognizes this and our endorsements do and will reflect our member's appreciation to candidates who are consistently and sincerely committed to a safer St. Paul.
